

Scottish Refugee Council Volunteers Equalities data November 2016

Scottish Refugee Council (SRC) is an independent charity which provides essential information and advice to people seeking asylum and refugees in Scotland. We also campaign for political change, raise awareness about issues that affect refugees, and work closely with local communities and organisations.

As a human rights charity, the principles of inclusiveness and diversity are at the foreground of our work, and we strive to ensure people with Protected Characteristics are able to access our volunteering opportunities, with a particular emphasis on encouraging the participation of our service users.

As of November 2016, we have 53 volunteers in 14 distinct roles within Scottish Refugee Council.

- 43% of SRC volunteers are people seeking asylum or refugees
- 9% of SRC volunteers are other BME or migrants
- 49% of volunteers are male
- 51% of volunteers are female
- 55% of volunteer are under 25
- 45% of volunteers are over 25
- %4 of volunteers have mobility issues
